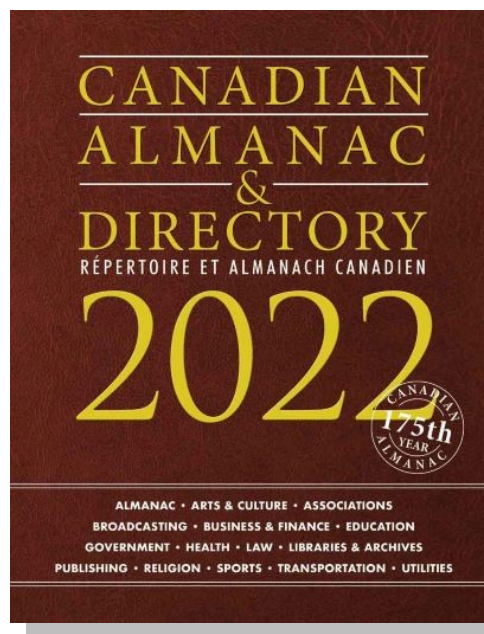
Section 13: Publishing details book, magazine, and newspaper publishers, detailing frequency, circulation figures, and more.
