This latest edition provides the most comprehensive picture of Canada, from physical attributes to economic and business summaries to leisure and recreation. It combines textual material, charts, colour photographs and directory listings. This 2025 edition includes hundreds more listings and thousands more details than its predecessor. The comprehensiveness and currency of data is unparalleled. Each of the 17 sections in the *Almanac* includes a detailed Table of Contents, outlining hundreds of subcategories.

- **Section 1: Almanac** comprises 10 major categories, including History, Vital Statistics, Geography, Science, Awards & Honours, Economics & more. Readers will find articles, colour maps and photographs, charts and tables for a fact-filled snapshot of Canada. This resource section is invaluable for residents, politicians, and the business community.
- **Section 2: Arts & Culture** begins the **Directory Listings** and includes nine categories: Aquaria, Art Galleries, Botanical Gardens, Museums, National Parks, Observatories, Performing Arts, Science Centres, and Zoos. Categories are arranged by province and city. All listings include address, phone, fax, website, email, key executives and a brief description.
- **Section 3: Associations** lists thousands of associations and organizations arranged in over 120 topics from Accounting to Youth. Each listing includes valuable descriptions and current contact information. An Association Name Index precedes the listings.
- **Section 4: Broadcasting** begins with Canada's Major Broadcasting Companies, then lists, by Province, all Radio and Television Stations, as well as Cable Companies and Specialty Broadcasters.
- **Section 5: Business & Finance** combines Accounting, Banking, Insurance, and Canada's Major Companies and Stock Exchanges. It includes a separate section for Major Accounting Firms with company descriptions, as well as an Insurance Class Index.
- **Section 6: Education** is arranged by Province, and includes Government Agencies, Districts, Specialized and Independent Schools, University and Technical facilities, many with valuable descriptions.
- **Section 7: Federal/Provincial Government** begins with a Quick Reference Guide to help you find your way around government agencies. The Guide is followed by Federal and Provincial listings, plus information on The Royal Family and Diplomatic and Consular Representative in Canada and abroad.

Section 8: Municipal Government details all County and Municipal Districts and segregated Major Municipalities. All profiles include date of incorporation, square miles, and population figures. Also included are District Maps and descriptions for all Provinces.

Section 9: Judicial Government provides thorough coverage for Courts in Canada, including Federal and Provincial. Listings are categorized by type of Court and City within each Province, and include presiding judges.

Section 10: Hospitals and Health Care Facilities is an overview of available facilities by Province. Government agencies, hospitals, community health centers, retirement care and mental health facilities, are all arranged alphabetically by city for easy access.

Section 11: Law Firms includes a separate section of Major Law Firms with descriptions and Senior Partners. Following the Majors are law firms arranged by Province.

Section 12: Libraries begins with Canada's main Library/Archive and Government Departments for Libraries. Provincial listings follow, with Regional Systems listed first, then Public Libraries and Archives.

Section 13: Publishing includes Publishers—Book, Magazine, Newspapers—and Newspapers by Province. Magazine listings are arranged in six major categories, preceded by a Magazine Name Index for easy searching. Details include frequency and circulation figures.

Section 14: Religion starts off with broad information on religious groups, and then lists Associations, arranged alphabetically by 37 denominations.

Section 15: Sports provides information on a variety of sports categories, including Associations, and detailed League and Team listings for Baseball, Basketball, Football, Hockey, Lacrosse, and Soccer. You'll also find the major sports venues in Canada, from stadiums to racetracks.

Section 16: Transportation offers comprehensive listings for major transportation modes, plus industry Associations, Government Agencies and Airport and port Authorities.

Section 17: Utilities includes Associations, Government Agencies, and Provincial Utility Companies.

In addition to the variety of sections included in this new edition, the *Canadian Almanac & Directory* includes a **Topical Table of Contents** in the front of the book, as well as an **Entry Name Index** in the back of the book. These, plus three indexes in the body of the work and tables of contents for each individual section, make easy work of finding exactly what you are looking for.

The *Almanac* continues to be widely used by business professionals, government officials, information specialists, researchers, publishers, and anyone needing current, accessible information on all topics relevant to those who live and work in Canada.
