A.C. Rutherford Collection of Western Canadiana

University of Alberta, Bruce Peel Special Collections Library

Subjects: Prairie Provinces—History; Prairie Provinces—Politics and government

Description: The collection contains first editions, pamphlets, and ephemera on prairie history and travel (Alberta, Saskatchewan, and Manitoba). Immigration literature is also included. The chronological emphasis is from the 17th century to the 19th century. Prairie Canadian monographs and ephemera are presently collected.

Language: English, French, and selected foreign language material.

Holdings: 6,000 monographs.

Physical Access: The collection is open to the public with identification. For further information visit: bpsc.library.ualberta.ca.

A.J.M. Smith Collection

Trent University, Thomas J. Bata Library

Subjects: Smith, Arthur James Marshall; Canadian poetry; Canadian literature

Description: The focus of the A.J.M. Smith Collection of books and periodicals is twentieth century Canadian poetry. The collection, from Smith's personal library, includes most of the publications of poets, from Duncan Campbell Scott to Bill Bissett. Most of the books, written by various Canadian poets, are presentation copies bearing inscriptions. The collection also contains twentieth century French Canadian poetry; signed copies of Smith's own books and articles; numerous works of fiction and studies in art, history, and economics; and complete or broken runs of English, American, and Canadian periodicals and poetry magazines. The library also houses the A.J.M. Smith Collection of Archives Material.

Language: English and French language material predominates.

Holdings: 1,200 volumes.

Physical Access: The collection is housed in a separate reading room which is open by appointment only. For further information visit: www.trentu.ca/library/archives.

A.J.T. Taylor Collection

University of British Columbia, Special Collections and University Archives Division

Subjects: Arctic regions—Discovery and exploration; Northwest Passage

Description: The collection contains material on the discovery and exploration of the Arctic regions and the exploration of the Northwest Passage. Many first editions of the major voyages to the Arctic and the searches for a Northwest Passage are present, very often in striking association copies. Most also have annotations by Stefansson. Maps of the Arctic region are included. The chronological emphasis is on eighteenth and nineteenth century voyages. The library purchases anything currently published on early Arctic discovery

and exploration. Excluded from present acquisitions is material on current scientific and technical writing.

Language: English, and selected material in French, German, and Russian.

Holdings: Taylor's library consisted of about 500 volumes: the collection has been supplemented by subsequent acquisitions of another ca. 500 volumes as well as archival materials and maps.

A.M. Donaldson Burns Collection

University of British Columbia, Special Collections and University Archives Division

Subjects: Burns, Robert; Scottish literature; Scotland—Description and travel

Description: The collection includes many different editions of Burns' works, critical and biographical materials, Scottish song books, works by other Scottish writers, and works about favourite "haunts" of Burns. The chronological emphasis is the late eighteenth and nineteenth centuries. However, the collection also includes current new items. Significant new editions, critical works, and ephemera are currently collected. Reprints or new editions without considerable new editorial work are not collected. The collection is not being developed extensively at present.

Language: English.

Holdings: 1,500 monographs; 1 serial; 1 serial currently received; a few manuscripts; many pamphlets and catalogues.

Abram Hoffer Orthomolecular Collection

University of Saskatchewan Libraries

Subjects: Psychiatry; Orthomolecular medicine; Nutrition; Mental health

Description: The collection consists of the personal collection of Saskatchewan-born psychiatrist Dr. Abram Hoffer, reflecting his interest in mental health, nutrition, orthomolecular medicine, and hallucinogens. Other topics covered by the collection include schizophrenia, cancer, alcoholism, and vitamin therapy.

Holdings: 1,520 books, including 65 authored or co-authored by Hoffer.

Adam Shortt Library of Canadiana

University of Saskatchewan Libraries

Subjects: Canada, Northwest; Prairie Provinces; Indians of North America; Arctic regions—Discovery and exploration; Railroads—Canada; Labour—Canada

Description: The collection includes material on the history of Western Canada, Arctic exploration, and native peoples. Particular emphasis is on prairie Canada. The collection is strong in early editions on exploration and

travel in the Arctic and the Prairies, the fur trade, and the railways in the West. Early and rare Canadiana also forms part of the collection. The geographic emphasis is on areas now within Canadian borders. Also included is some material on the U. S. northern Plains and Oregon territories, during periods when these areas were intimately involved in Canadian affairs. Government publications after 1867 and current journals are excluded from the collection. Present acquisition priorities are for older rare material. Attempts are also made to purchase current monographic material on Canadian history and Western Canadiana. Recent collecting has focused on social history, especially labour and women's history.

Language: English, French, and selected foreign language material.

Holdings: Approximately 50,000 volumes. 17,000 monographs; scattered reels of microfilm; 12 linear metres of vertical files.

Agricola Collection

Dalhousie University, MacRae Library

Subjects: Agriculture—education, technology and research

Description: The MacRae Library has housed this collection since 1912. It contains archival material on agricultural education, technology, and research, including the Edith Zillig Sheep Fonds, Atlantic Canada Co-op Archives, textual documents, and photographs. Materials were mainly donated by people associated with the school. There is also a museum collection with maps, artifacts, and farming and household implements.

Holdings: 20,000 items, including old books, documents, maps, manuscripts, and photographs. Special collections hold monographs, serials, and manuscripts.

Some ephemeral items, e.g., exhibition and book dealers' catalogues, are rarely available elsewhere. Books on printing processes and types of illustrations. Collection is added to through gifts and purchases.

Language: English.

Holdings: Approximately 3,500 items.

Alberta Folklore and Local History Collection

University of Alberta, Bruce Peel Special Collections Library

Subjects: Prairie Provinces—History; Folklore; 20th Century

Description: The collection includes manuscripts, radioscripts, plays, stories, tall tales, reminiscences, poems, school yearbooks, newspapers, and photographs from 1943-1945. It was originally created by the Alberta Folklore and Local History Project, which was established by the Department of Extension at the University of Alberta with the help of a grant from the Rockefeller Foundation.

Language: Primarily English; local Indigenous and non-English speaking immigrant communities are indirectly reflected.

Holdings: Ephemera, manuscripts, newspapers, photographs.

Alexander Pope Collection

McMaster University, Mills Memorial Library

Subjects: Pope, Alexander; English poetry

Description: The collection includes eighteenth century editions of Alexander Pope's works, in first and variant editions. Manuscripts are excluded from the collection. Present acquisition policy is to acquire any available Pope items from the eighteenth century.

Language: English, French, Latin, and German.

Holdings: 200 monographs.

Alice 100 Collection

University of British Columbia, Special Collections and University Archives Division

Subjects: Carroll, Lewis; Alice's Adventures in Wonderland; Through the Looking Glass

Description: The collection was created to celebrate the 100th anniversary of the first publication of *Alice* in 1865, and contains hundreds of editions of *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* and *Through the Looking Glass*, including an 1866 first edition. Other works by and about Lewis Carroll are also featured.

Holdings: Approximately 500 books displaying the work of more than 80 illustrators; musical and stage productions; film stills; translations.

Anabaptist/Mennonite Collection

Conrad Grebel University College, Milton Good Library

Subjects: Mennonites—History; Mennonites—Doctrines; Anabaptists—History; Anabaptists—History—Sources

Description: The scope of the Anabaptist Collection is primarily theological and intellectual history with an emphasis on sixteenth century northern and central Europe. Anabaptist sources on file are comprehensive. The extensive Mennonite Collection is broader and includes material on history, sociology, literature, cooking, genetic studies, education, theology, and cultural and anthropological studies. The emphasis of the Mennonite materials is on nineteenth and twentieth century North America. There are also some holdings on Europe and South America. The microfiche collection consists largely of the IDC sixteenth century German pamphlet collection and the Mennonite Sources Collection. The collection relies on the University of Waterloo for broader Reformation materials. Recent acquisition pol-

icy is to acquire current material and as funding permits, retrospective works. The Mennonite Archives are also located at Conrad Grebel University College.

Language: Multilingual.

Holdings: 5,000 monographs; 900 serials; 4,000 titles on microform; 450 film titles; 600 audiotapes; picture files.

Physical Access: Anabaptist/Mennonite materials are not separated from the rest of the library collection, with the exception of rare materials which are located in the rare books section. Antiquarian Booksellers' and Auction Catalogues

University of Toronto, Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library

Subjects: Booksellers—Catalogues; Auction houses—Catalogues; Antiquarian booksellers

Description: The collection is a large and growing collection of British, American, and European book dealers, and auction catalogues. It includes substantial runs of the catalogues of the premier firms from the mid-nineteenth century to the present. The collection is expanded regularly through gift, subscription, and purchase. Language: English, French, German, Italian, Spanish, Dutch, and the Scandinavian languages.

Holdings: Approximately 100,000 items.

Apiculture Collection

University of Guelph, McLaughlin Library

Subjects: Apiculture (Bee culture)

Description: The collection contains periodicals, monographs, and rare books on apiculture. Also included are beekeeping journals from various countries; virtually complete files of the major periodicals; and most pre-1800 monographs. Among items in Dr. B. N. Gates' personal library are several hundred monographs; serials (including scarce turn-of-the century American journals); beekeeping supply catalogues from North America and some sample catalogues from Europe; Gates' personal archives; a 10,000 card apiculture bibliography; an extensive photograph collection; ephemera; and historic beekeeping equipment. These are included selectively. The library continues to develop the collection to support research and teaching in apiculture.

Language: Multilingual.

Holdings: 2,300 monographs; 1,000 volumes of bound journals; 31 serials currently received; 5,000 reprints; 300 picture files; 3.9 linear metres of manuscripts; artifacts (beekeeping equipment).

Physical Access: Rare and archival material is located in a special collections area. The collection is open to the public. For further information visit:

Archibald Lampman Collection

Queen's University, Douglas Library, W.D. Jordan Special Collections and Music Library

Subjects: Lampman, Archibald; Canadian poetry

Description: The collection includes Archibald Lampman's (1861-1899) literary works in all variant editions, and nineteenth century literary periodicals and newspapers. Secondary critical works on Lampman are also included. New editions and critical works are acquired as they become available.

Language: English.

Holdings: 72 monographs; 1 vertical file (3 items); manuscripts. Supplementary material to support this collection will be found in the main stacks collection.

Ariel Bension Sephardic Manuscript Collection

University of Alberta, Bruce Peel Special Collections Library

Subjects: Sephardic Judaism; Hebrew language

Description: The collection is the first to include Hebrew language works found in Canada, and is a significant collection of Sephardic writings worldwide. Writings date from the twelfth to the nineteenth century, showcasing three variants of Sephardic script. The collection was originally compiled by Dr. Ariel Bension, a noted early twentieth century scholar of Semitic languages, and was acquired by the University of Alberta in 1973.

Language: Hebrew; Ladino (Judeo-Spanish).

Holdings: Books, correspondence, ephemera, manuscripts.

Physical Access: The collection is open to the public with identification. For further information visit: bpsc.library.ualberta.ca/collections/ariel-bension-sephardic-manuscripts.

Aristotle Collection

University of Toronto, Thomas Fisher Rare Book Library

Subjects: Aristotle; Philosophy, Greek

Description: The collection contains important editions of Aristotle's works and commentaries on them by such writers as Walter Burley, Egidio Colonna, Duns Scotus, Joannes de Janduno, and Thomas Aquinas. Some works about Aristotle and his writings are also included. Most of the material is pre-1650. A unique item in the collection appears to be the earliest extant manuscript of *Questiones in Aristotelis De caelo et mundo* by Albert of Saxony (d. 1390). It was completed at Sienna in May, 1407. The library collects early important editions or commentaries when possible.

Language: Multilingual. Aristotle's works are in Greek and Latin. Most commentaries are in Latin.

Holdings: Approximately 200 volumes; some manuscripts of commentaries.

Physical Access: The collection is open to the public with identification. For further information visit: fisher.library.utoronto.ca.

Arkley Collection of Historical Children's Literature

University of British Columbia, Special Collections and University Archives Division

Subjects: Children's literature; Carroll, Lewis

Description: The collection contains British and North American children's books from the late eighteenth century to 1939. The collection is particularly strong in material by and about Lewis Carroll. Some unique items include Canadian "firsts", early editions of classics, and works of important illustrators. Works published after 1939 and journals are excluded from the collection (these are housed in the general stacks instead). The collection relies largely on gifts. Few purchases are made to develop the collection at present. However, if important Canadian items become available through local dealers, attempts are made to purchase them. In 1995, the Library received a SSHRC grant of \$20,000 to strengthen the collection.

Language: English.

Holdings: 5,000 monographs; a few manuscripts.

Physical Access: The collection is in Rare Books and Special Collections which is open to the public. For further information visit: guides.library.ubc.ca/historicalchildrensliterature/arkley.

As of March 2014, Government of Canada Publications no longer sells or distributes government publications in tangible formats, opting instead for an electronic-only catalogue (www.publications.gc.ca), which features over 502,000 publications, 381,000 of them digital. In April 2014, the Depository Services Program (DSP) ceased distributing tangible government publications to depository libraries, after the agreements between the DSP and the depositories expired the previous year. According to the Publishing and Depository Services Directorate (PDSD), while many of these libraries continue to make Government of Canada publications available within their collections, the nature and subject types held in those collections varies depending on the demographics of the population they serve. The following list of depository libraries is based on the last-available list provided by the PDSD, and has been updated since with current contact information.
