

Introduction

This 2018 edition of *Associations Canada* published by Grey House Publishing Canada includes over 20,000 associations, both those that are headquartered in Canada, as well as those headquartered elsewhere with branches in Canada. The Canadian associations are followed by a separate section of Foreign Associations that are of a particular interest to Canadians.

Content

Associations Canada has been a valued reference tool for over three decades, providing the most comprehensive picture of Canada's non-profit sector. This 2018 Grey House Canada edition is no exception. The Canadian organizations and international groups in this edition represent industry, commercial and professional associations, registered charities, and special and common interest organizations. This 39th annual edition includes updates or verification of all major associations, as well as all meetings and conferences. Included are over 12,000 awards and publications, and close to 35,000 executive contacts.

Each listing presents a detailed association profile, including budget, founding date, scope of activity, licensing body, sources of funding, executive information, full address and complete contact information.

- **Arrangement of Data:** Each profile has boldfaced category headers to help users quickly identify categories of information: **Previous Name; Overview; Chief Officers; Finances; Staff; Membership; Activities; Publications; and Mission.**

Cette édition 2018 des *Associations du Canada*, publiée par Grey House Publishing Canada, comprend plus de 20 000 associations, dont celles ayant leur siège social au Canada et celles qui, bien qu'ayant leur siège social à l'étranger, ont des succursales ou des divisions au Canada. On y dresse également le profil d'associations étrangères d'un intérêt particulier pour les Canadiens.

Contenu

- Communication numbers, including crisis-lines, info-lines, TTY, toll-free telephone numbers, email & website addresses.
- Social media addresses, including LinkedIn, Facebook, and Twitter links.
- Previous Name: If the name of an association has changed, the previous name appears with a note to see the entry under its new name.
- Also Known As: If an association is better known by a more popular name, this name appears as well.
- Previous Name/ Merged From: If the name of an association has changed, its former name appears as well.
- Overview: This description includes the size (small, medium-sized, large), the jurisdiction (international, national, provincial, local), whether it's a charitable or licensing organization, the year it was founded in and the name of the organization it is overseen by.
- A mission statement
- The organizations of which it is a member or with which it is affiliated.

- Finances: This includes the annual operating budget and the funding sources of the association.
- Staff: Includes both paid and volunteer staff.
- Membership: The number of members, often in specific categories (e.g. individual, corporate, senior, lifetime); fees; the membership criteria; and committees on the board of members.
- Activities: Highlights what the association does, apart from the information contained in its mission statement.
- This includes speakers services and internship programs, awareness events, and whether they have a library or sell mailing lists.
- Chief Officers: Titles may include the following: Executive Director, Director, President, Executive Secretary, Treasurer, Sec.-Treas., General Manager, Coordinator, Chair, Superintendent, Representative, Registrar, Program Head, etc.; eligible for inclusion are both permanent and elected staff. See also the Executive Name Index.
- Awards, Scholarships, Grants: Prizes awarded by the association, along with the amount.
- Publications: Includes details on frequency, author/editor, ISSN or ISBN, language(s) the publication is available in, number of pages, price, advertising, and description of bibliographic contents.
- Meetings: The dates and locations for events to be held in 2018–2023. See also the Conferences and Conventions Index.
- Branches: The association may have various branches, listed at the bottom.
