This 2025-2026 edition organizes all entries into five broad chapters: **Public Libraries; College & University Libraries; Special Libraries; Library Services & Resources; and Library Associations, Consortia & Groups**. The updated edition is comprised of:

- Section one, **Public Libraries**
 - Listings are arranged alphabetically by Province, then Regional System.

Branches are listed in alphabetical order under their central branch. There are 3,322 listings in this first section

- Section two, **College & University Libraries**
 - o This section includes 613 institutional libraries that are arranged alphabetically by Province.
- Section three, **Special Libraries**
 - o 2,242 libraries in six sub categories, including Archive, Business & Finance, Government, Health, Legal, and Other.
- Section four, **Library Services & Resources**
 - o Nearly 300 total listings, including general and company information on Book Wholesalers, Periodicals, Subscription Agencies, Supplies & Software, Digital Catalogues, and Conferences, Meetings & Workshops.
- Section five, **Library Associations, Consortia & Groups**
 - o Over 300 listings crucial to the health of Canada's library industry, with categories such as Library Associations, Library Consortia: Library Schools, Provincial Agencies, and Regional Systems.

Following section five are two appendices. Appendix 1 lists over 280 special collections in Canadian libraries that have been determined to be of research value, while **Appendix 2** lists approximately 800 depository libraries of Canadian government information.

Rounding out this directory for easier access are **Six Indexes: Entry Name Index**—all 6,777 listings in alphabetical order; **Archive Index**—all archival libraries in alphabetical order; **Government Libraries Index**—all government libraries in alphabetical order; **Location Index**—all listings by province, then city; **Personnel Index**—all key contact and their affiliated library; and **Subject Index**—libraries categorized by 40 defining topics to help users find just the collection they're looking for.
